INTRODUCTION

Christmas Island is a dot in the Indian Ocean, an Australian Territory and its closest neighbor is Java which is 360km away. Come October, the people of Christmas Island will celebrate their 50th Territory Anniversary. If you are a nature lover, Christmas Island is for you! 63% of it is national park containing species of flora found no where else in the world. Probably the most noticeable local is the Red Crab with over 100 million of these vivid red creatures living on the forest floor.



GEOGRAPHIC

Christmas Island is the summit of a submarine rising steeply to a central plateau dominated by stands of rainforest. This plateau reaches heights of up to 361 metres and consists mainly of limestones and layers of volcanic rock.

The Island's 80km coastline is an almost continuous sea cliff of up to 20 metres in height. In a few places, the cliff gives way to shallow bays with small sand and coral shingles beaches. The largest of these bays forms the Island's only port, Flying Fish Cove.

The Island is surrounded by a narrow encircling coral reef. There is virtually no coastal shelf and the sea plummets to a depth of about 500 metres within 200 metres of a shore.
